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Ophthalmic ointment or solution may be used to soothe the eyelids of the child unburned, irritated or sore.
Keep the eyelids open at the widest part of the baby's eyes.
Wipe the baby's eyes with absorbent cotton moistened in warm boiled water as soon as the head is born.
Burn the cotton used; the disease is infectious.
Do not include the eyes in the first general bath.
